Sporting Events

Year 5/6 Girls Rugby Team – Bronze Medallists

Year 5/6 Football Team finished 2nd in the Swansea City Tournament after a nail-biting final which ended as a draw, then went to extra time and finished with a golden goal.

Emily Roberts (Yr6) won a gold medal in the 50m Breaststroke at the Urdd National Swimming Gala.

Dyfed Cross Country – all children who took part did exceptionally well. Erin Powell (Yr4) and James Sloyan (Yr5) finished in the top ten and each received a medal.

Sporting Activities

Years 3, 5 and 6 have taken part in various sporting activities led by the students at Trinity Saint David University.

Our Year 6 Bronze Ambassadors – Zac, Isaac T, Charlie, Ashleigh and Lillybelle have started running their sports club for Year3 pupils.

Lead Creative Schools Project

This term year 4 pupils have been taking part in the Lead Creative

Schools scheme managed and funded by the Arts Council of Wales. The group of 17 year 4 pupils have been working with community artist Rowan O'Neill to map links over time between the school, the town and the wider world.

As well as a trip to the National Library they have also visited the submerged forest at Borth and Carmarthen Museum in the company of poet Elinor Wyn Reynolds where they created a collaborative poem in response to their trip.

The results of the project will be shared with the school through the People's Collection website

(www.peoplescollection.wales), a heritage and community resource for the whole of Wales which allows people to share photos and memories and map these to their locations.
